- Finding the right word for what they want to say (Aphasia)
- Getting off topic
- Talking around a topic, never getting to the point
- Trouble understanding what is said to them
- Difficulty keeping up with a fast-paced conversation (especially when talking to more than one person)
- Starting a conversation
- Speaking very fast or slow
- Talking about topics that are too personal
- Talking about topics or in a way that is offensive to others
- Taking turn in conversation
- Using an appropriate tone of voice
- Interpreting the subtleties of conversation (The difference between sarcasm and a serious statement)
- Responding to facial expressions and body language on their own
